Amorita's Unique Recent History

(Unique from other antique yachts, including NY-30's)

Her hull is remarkably original and intact, retaining over 90% of her original planking. She retains much of her original hardware, including her bronze strapping, chocks and windlass.

Amorita is the only NY-30 to win the Sapho Trophy, for the best corrected time during the Museum of Yachting's Classic Yacht Regatta.

Amorita is the only yacht, ever, to win the Sapho Trophy, back-to-back (2000-2001).

Amorita is the only NY-30 to win the Atlantic Trophy, for the best elapsed time during the Museum of Yachting's Classic Yacht Regatta.

Amorita holds the record as the most successful Herreshoff yacht to compete in the Museum of Yachting Classic Yacht Regatta.

Amorita holds the record as the most successful Gaff Rigged yacht to compete in the Museum of Yachting Classic Yacht Regatta.

Amorita is the only yacht to win both the Museum of Yachting's and Mystic Seaport's Best of Show restoration awards in the same year.

Amorita has participated in 24 continuous Museum of Yachting Classic Yacht Regattas, more than all but one other yacht.

Amorita's percentage of winning (or placing) over the past decade in New England area regattas is higher than any other classic yacht.

Images of *Amorita* are the highest grossing photographs among all yachts featured in Onne Van Der Wal's gallery of marine photography.

Images of *Amorita* have graced more magazine covers, calendars, and related materials than all but a very few yachts in recent history, and is, indeed, the smallest and oldest yacht elevated to this position of prominence.

Amorita, and no other NY-30, was selected as one of North America's 100 Greatest Yachts by the editors of *Sail Magazine*.

Amorita, and no other NY-30, was selected as the standard in which NY-30 Class scale models were created, selling world-wide for over three years.

Over the past decade, *Amorita* has consistently defeated all other NY-30's on a regular basis, with the highest frequency of winning the NY-30 Class award at the Museum of Yachting Classic Yacht Regatta, as well as other similar events.
